

CIRCULAR ECONOMY POLICY.

This policy establishes Negratín's commitment to the Circular Economy in all its activities related to the design, manufacture, installation and operation of its photovoltaic projects. Our goal is to reduce the consumption of natural resources, minimize waste generation and maximize the reuse, recycling and recovery of materials, contributing to the transition towards a sustainable energy model.

This policy applies to:

- All areas of the company.
- Suppliers, contractors and strategic partners involved in the value chain.
- Photovoltaic projects in all their phases: design, construction, operation and maintenance.

This policy is governed by a series of principles:

1. ECODESIGN

- Select recyclable and durable materials.
- Prioritise components with a lower carbon footprint.
- Incorporate energy efficiency criteria in the design phase to reduce resource consumption.

2. EXTENSION OF SERVICE LIFE

- Implement preventive maintenance programs in our Operation and Maintenance activities to maximize the durability of the equipment.
- Promote the repair and refurbishment of components.

3. REUSE AND RECYCLING

- Recover modules, inverters and structures for refurbishment or recycling, trying to avoid final disposal whenever possible.

4. RESPONSIBLE WASTE MANAGEMENT

- Comply with WEEE (Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment) regulations and promote the traceability of the waste generated in all phases of the project.
- Promote the segregation and recovery of materials to reduce environmental impact.

5. SUPPLIER COLLABORATION

- Require sustainable practices and environmental certifications in the supplier approval process, ensuring that the supply chain is aligned with our principles.

6. INNOVATION

- To promote solutions that reduce the use of virgin raw materials and increase energy efficiency, while maintaining our strategy of incorporating state-of-the-art equipment.
